## **Process for Member Judging Of "Best Photo"**

- 1. The photos are those provided by members and viewed at the NCPC main meeting.
- 2. After the meeting, a link will be provided to the photos viewed at the main meeting to all members via email. This email will also specify the date at which the scores and the completed worksheet is to be provided (Reference 5 below).

Those photos are those which meet the requirements as specified in the "NCPC Members Best Photos Description" <a href="https://www.northcobbphotoclub.com/best-photo-of-the-month-document.html">https://www.northcobbphotoclub.com/best-photo-of-the-month-document.html</a>

The photos will not identify the photographer and will not include the metadata.

Each photo will be identified with a sequential number beginning with 1.

All members will be invited to vote.

- 3. The members, who wish to vote, will obtain a copy of the "NCPC Photo Judging Worksheet" <a href="https://www.northcobbphotoclub.com/ncpc-photo-judging-worksheet-and-process.html">https://www.northcobbphotoclub.com/ncpc-photo-judging-worksheet-and-process.html</a>
- 4. The Member will evaluate each photo, except his/hers, per instructions on the Worksheet, including the totals.
- 5. The Member will provide Jim Huwaldt (<a href="https://huwaldtj@gmail.com">huwaldtj@gmail.com</a>) the total numeric score for each photo reviewed.

Also provide a copy of the completed worksheet. Provide no later than the date specified when the link, to the photos, is provided (Reference 2 above).

Suggestions are to scan or photo the completed Worksheet.

Then provide via email or cloud link.

6. At the designated 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday Special Program Virtual Meeting we will identify the top four photos and discuss in detail the attributes of each photo.

The identity of the photographers will be shown at the meeting, but not that of the reviewing members.
